2023 Home Design Trends: Expert Predictions

As some of the top experts in interior design, we wanted to get their predictions for what are going to be the biggest home trends in 2023. We simply asked them to complete the following sentence: "In residential interior design in 2023, one of the most popular trends we will see is..." We have gathered their responses and here is what they have to say.

1. An Emphasis on Incorporating More Color

Nicole White, *Nicole White Designs Interiors*, enthusiastically claims how expressing individuality will be popular, stating “More pattern, more color, more texture!” **Anna Gibson**, *AKG Design Studio*, shares the enthusiasm for color by saying; “Colors! We are moving away from gray and white in the wide world of colors.” **Garrison Hullinger**, *Garrison Hullinger Interior Design*, believes that “Adding saturated colors and bolder patterns will continue to trend in 2023.”

2. Sustainability

One trend that is emerging in the coming year is the awareness of using more sustainable materials throughout the home. **Jeanne Chung**, Founder & Editor of *Cozy•Stylish•Chic*, agrees by simply stating “sustainability” as an upcoming popular trend. **Wendy Yates**, Founder of *Abigail-Elise Design Studio*, shares the sentiment by saying, “We will see a big shift towards sustainably sourced goods”. **Shivani Vyas**, Owner and Founder of *Studio Vyas*, states that next year we will see an “Emphasis on bringing in natural, sustainable materials in remodeling and renovation projects.”

3. Warm Colors

Linda Merrill, *Linda Merrill Decorative Surroundings*, believes that “Warm neutrals with deeper richer color accents” will be one of the most popular home design trends. And she’s not alone. **Jessica Love**, *Urbane Design Studios*, says we’ll see more “Warm wood tones”, while **Laura Medicus** exclaims that, “Warm colors will continue to be popular!”

4. Nature Inspired Design

A trend continuing from last year is the use of design elements that are inspired by nature. **Rose Dostal**, Founder of *RMD Designs LLC*, comments that the trends will be “Very much nature inspired, for example, in wallpaper, the large botanical patterns and in casegoods, the use of wood in its more natural light matte stained color.” She continues to state that “Earthy tones” will also be popular.

5. A Focus on Wellness

Making the home a sanctuary through the use of design is one trend experts are predicting. **Amy Lau**, *Amy Lau Design*, says “I think we are looking to improve the quality of our lives and living spaces and for this reason I am seeing a trend of more emphasis on using artwork for the walls.” **Ellen Kennon** agrees; “More focus on creating healing environments using the energy of color and nature.” **Chelsie Butler**, Executive Editor of *Kitchen & Bath Business Magazine*, feels the same, saying that “Design for wellness” will be among the most popular interior design trends in 2023. **Michelle Cortizo**, *Cortizo Interiors*, adds that “Wellness is and will be a major focus.”
